Dear Mr. Rekucki:

You have an incomplete permit application for a mound septic system. No design or soils information was presented, and the information cannot be verified at this time. The permit is denied, and a full refund has been initiated.

A number of attempts have been made to subdivide the above-reference parcel. Our office has conducted field visits on the information provided and have not agreed with the findings.

Because it has already been subdivided in past years, no permits will be issued on parcel #12-0-017300 until two 5000 square foot standard septic sites have been identified, along with a 3,000 square foot building site. These must be entirely in non-wetland areas, and no wetland fill can be done to reach the potential building or septic sites. **Any subdivision application must be accompanied by an approved wetland delineation.**

Because it is also part of a previous subdivision, and all allowed wetland fill was used on the subdivision process, parcel #12-0-017304 can have no fill placed on it, or it will be in violation of the Wetland Conservation Act.
