Hello Jeff,

We are adding some additional conditions to your permit on parcel 35-0-033605. If you agree to them and understand them, we can finish processing your permit ASAP.

The maximum allowed excavation and or placement of material in a shore impact zone is 30 cubic yards so you need to keep the total amount under that. If there is more than 30 cubic yards excavation and or placement of material you will need a variance.

1. You need a silt fence at the lake to prevent silt from getting into the lake until the vegetation is growing in the disturbed area.
2. No further vegetation removal on the property without a permit.
3. Revegetation of the excavated area ASAP
4. Beveling the sides of the excavation back three feet to slow erosion along the excavated area.
5. Placement of 2 coir logs (10 foot sections one top of the other) at the edge of the lake directly below the excavated area to help hold the sediment along the shore until ground is revegetated.

We are also suggesting you adding 2-3" black dirt to the excavated area to speed revegetation.

Mostly we are concerned with erosion into the lake as the sand on site is highly erodible.
