Thank you very much for talking with me today to discuss this Storm Water Management Plan.

Per our discussion:

Description of project/plan:

Our Project is a Land use permit: This will be a Sand Patio that is 20x30 feet, the sand patio will be 10ft way from the high water mark.

Our plan is to turn up the soil and maintain the sand without the grass. The space with the sand opening will be 20x30ft. The area around the Sand Patio is grass and has some shrubs. These will remain in place.

At the water's edge there is a natural berm that is in place, this will be maintained by the land owner. Additionally the land owner will maintain 10 feet of grass around the sand patio. The natural slope to the water is approximately 3%. The land owner will maintain a berm at bottom of the sand patio towards the water to assist with minimizing erosion. This man made berm will be approximately 2-3in rise.
