

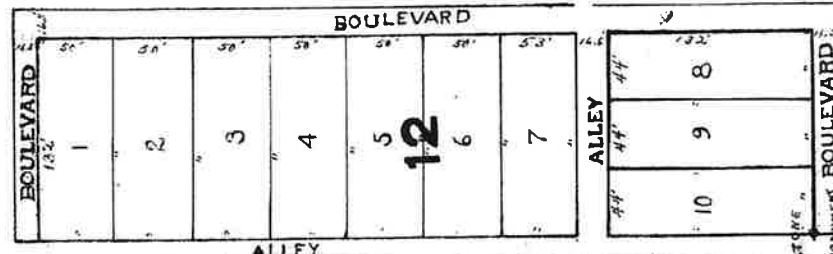
for ornament and shade, and that they be preserved by the proper authorities of the town, county, or state, and planted also further that the sidewalks on the boulevard districts be laid 2 1/2 feet from the lot line, with a width not exceeding 6 feet, thus leaving trees, etc. on each side of the walk.

I am witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals, this 28th. day of September, A. D. 1900.

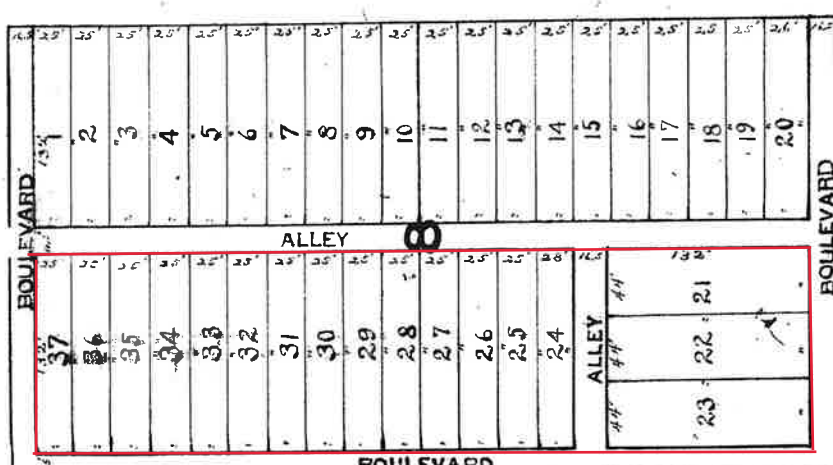

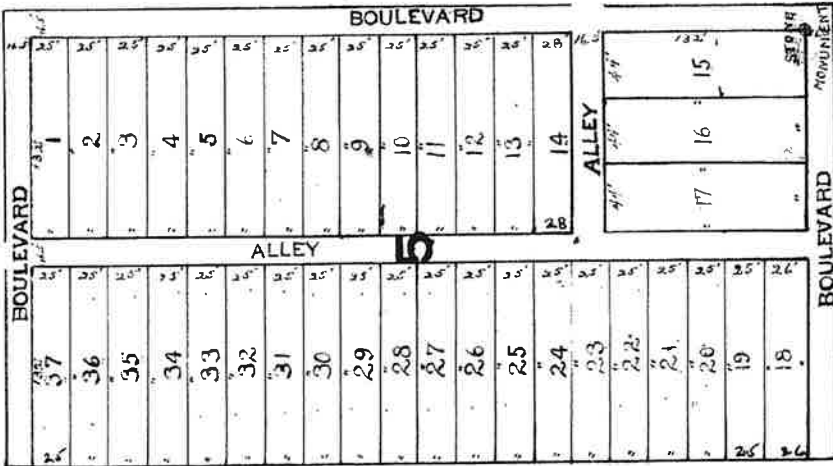

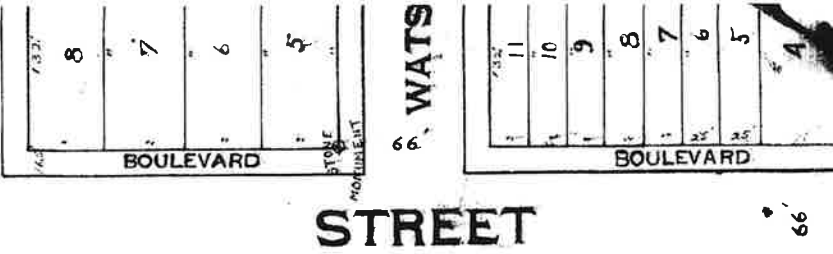
