Hi Laurie,

Thanks for getting back to me so quickly. While using it as a holding tank, an alarm needs to be hooked up if there is not one already. When you do hook it up to the Drainfield you will need to:

- 1. Have the pump hooked up to power.
- 2. Install an event counter to monitor the flow. The event counter will need to be calibrated upon installation. Give Tim at Timber Lakes Septic a call and he can help you with these services.
- 3. Once the event counter is installed, you will need to record the event counter readings once a month or when present. This is to monitor the amount of water going into the system. Attached is a flow monitoring form to keep track of readings and report to our office when the operating permit is due for renewal.
- 4. Please notify me when the system is fully hooked up and I will reactivate your operating permit.

After reading his report it looks like you are just using the holding tank and you don't have a pump or counter installed yet to use the mound. In that case the operating permit will be on pause until you are fully hooked up and using the mound. Let me know when that happens and until then you don't have to do anything with renewing this operating permit. To continue using just the holding tank we should have from you a pumping agreement from your pumper. Timber Lakes has the form if they are the ones doing your pumping you can contact them for it.
